- 11 premium boards with minimum thickness of 22 mm
- 9 high-quality pressboard or solid wood blocks

BRANDING

• 78 rivet/convex ring nails, 40/55 mm, 70 mm or 90 mm in length



NAILS

- Nails with head marking
- Minimum of 3 to 4 nails (possibly more if repairs carried out)
- Uniform and recurrent pattern
- Largest possible space between nails and to the pallet edges
